

Opportunities to Study Virtually

Virtual NSLI-Y is a 10-week, beginner-level foreign language and culture experience that takes place after school during the Fall and Spring terms. Participants are placed in teacher-led classes that meet twice a week for 90-minutes.







NSLI-Y programs offer:

- Merit-based full scholarships for American high school students
- Overseas language immersion programs
- Beginning, intermediate and advanced language classes
- Host family experience
- Alumni engagement to continue language learning and explore language-focused career opportunities
